- All students who are not majors in the SBA, whether they have applied for a minor or not, are limited to a <u>maximum of 25% of their total degree credits in business courses</u>. (This restriction also applies to Economics majors who are either in the College of Arts & Sciences or the SBA.)
- All economics (ECN) courses and QMM 250 and QMM 452 are excluded from this 25% calculation.
- The maximum of 25% of total degree credits includes courses taken at Oakland University and all previous colleges.
- Transfer students are required to take a minimum of 9 credits in the minor at Oakland University and at least 6 of these 9 credits must be in 300-level courses or higher.

A MINIMUM GRADE OF 2.0 IS REQUIRED FOR EACH COURSE FOR THE MINOR.
