**A 2.0 IS REQUIRED FOR EACH COURSE IN EACH MAJOR. PRE-BUSINESS AND UNDECIDED BUSINESS STUDENTS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO TAKE ANY 300- OR 400-LEVEL SBA COURSES with the exception of ACC 310, ECN 303, FIN 322, MIS 300, MKT 302, ORG 330 and POM 343. A student may not double major in general management and another major in the SBA, but other combinations are allowed. See catalog for available minors.
